Application Qualifications

Freshman Applicants

Those who have foreign nationalities and who satisfy all of the following qualifications are eligible.

- (1) Those who have completed 12 years of regular education outside Japan or expect to complete such education before the end of March 2021.
* Applicants attended in a local elementary school, junior high school or high school in Japan within 4 years will qualify for admission. However, it is not applicable if applicants graduate or expect to graduate from a high school of Japan.
- (2) From among the "EJU" by JASSO, those who have taken the subjects specified by each faculty in the "Admissions Guide". * Language of examination must be "Japanese".
- (3) Those who can demonstrate sufficient English language proficiency with the score of one of the followings: TOEFL® TEST, TOEIC® LISTENING AND READING TEST or IELTS (Academic Module).

Third-Year Transfer Applicants

Those who have foreign nationalities and who satisfy all of the following qualifications are eligible.

- (1) Those who have completed 14 years of regular education outside Japan or expect to complete such education before the end of March 2021.
* Applicants must have completed 2 years of degree program outside Japan by the time of transfer to be eligible for admission.
- (2) Same as the above qualification (2) for Freshman Applicants.
- (3) Same as the above qualification (3) for Freshman Applicants.

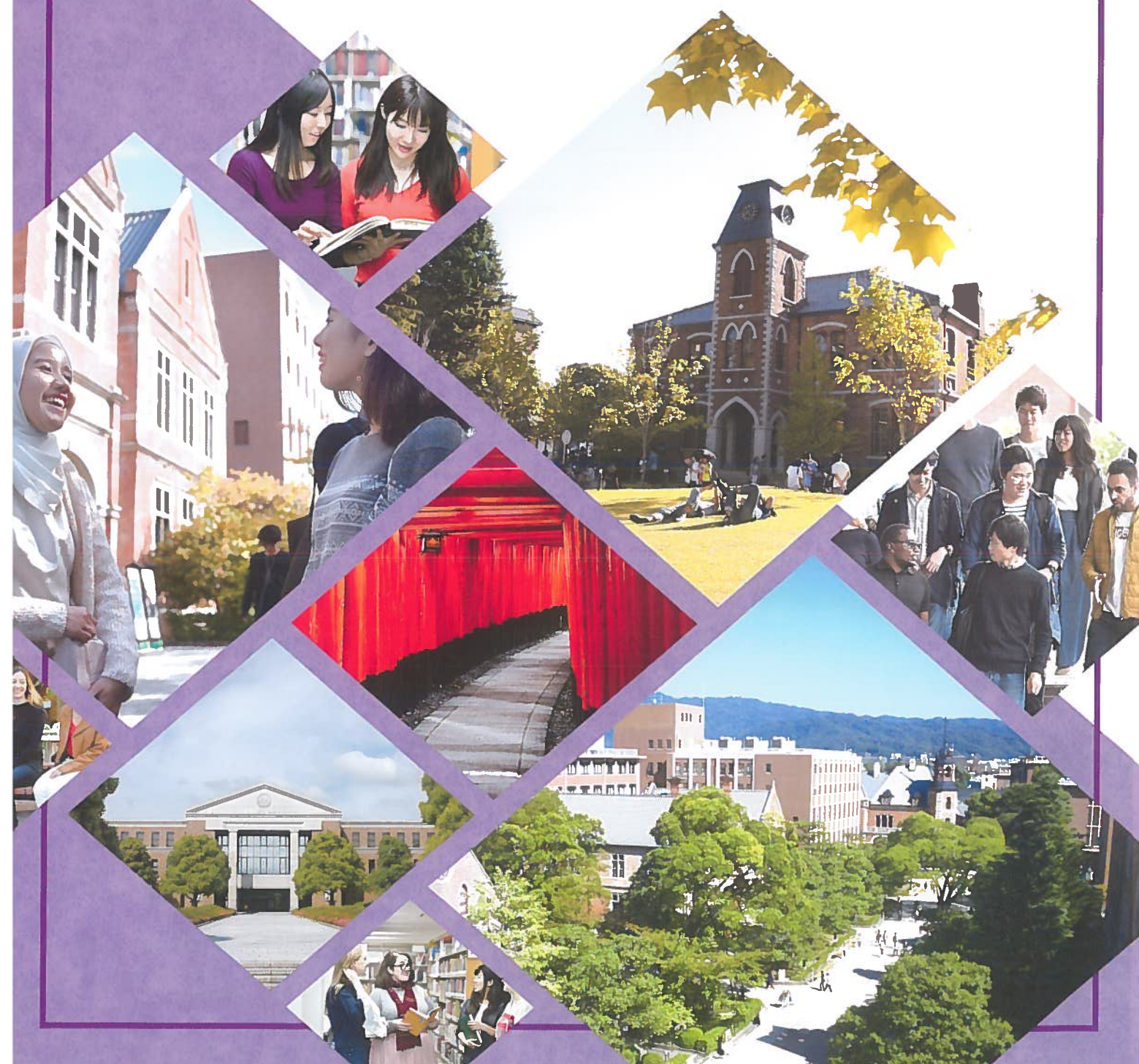

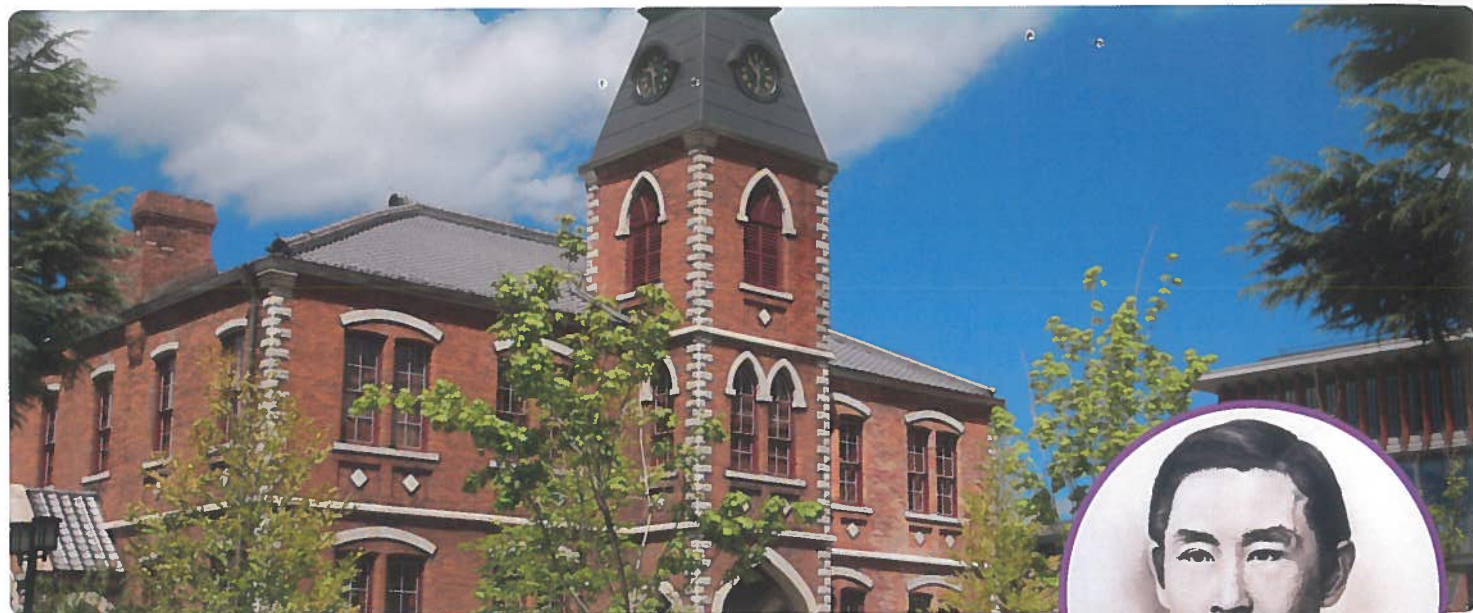

Doshisha University

About Doshisha

同志社大学について

Doshisha University was founded in 1875 by Joseph Hardy Neesima (Jo Nijima) as Doshisha Eigakko (Academy) with 8 students and 2 teachers. Born as a son of a samurai during the final years of the Edo period, Neesima saw an urgent need to study in the West, so he risked his life to leave Japan, and studied in the U.S. In those days, traveling overseas was strictly prohibited by the Tokugawa authorities. He studied at Phillips Academy, Amherst College, and Andover Theological Seminary and obtained his Bachelor of Science degree from Amherst College. It is said that he is the first Japanese person to receive a degree from a Western institution of higher learning. After his return to Japan, he founded the predecessor of Doshisha University, which is now one of the oldest private institutions of higher learning in Japan.

同志社は新島襄により、学生8名、教員2名の同志社英学校として、1875年に設立されました。江戸時代末期に武士の子供として生まれた新島襄は、日本の未来のために、進んだ欧米の国々に学ぶ必要性を感じ、日本を離れ、アメリカで学ぶことを決意しました。当時、徳川幕府により、海外へ行くことは禁じられていました。新島襄は、フィリップスアカデミー、アーモスト大学、アンドーヴァー神学校で学び、アーモスト大学から Bachelor of Science の学位を取得しました。西洋の高等教育機関において学位を取得した初めての日本人と言われています。その後、新島襄は日本に戻り、日本で最も古い私立の高等教育の学校のひとつである同志社英学校を創立しました。

Characteristic

The Doshisha Educational Corporation consists of one kindergarten, two elementary schools, four junior and senior high schools, of which one of them is an international junior and senior high school, and two universities, which are Doshisha University and Doshisha Women's College of Liberal Arts. Altogether, approximately 43,000 students are currently enrolled at these institutions.

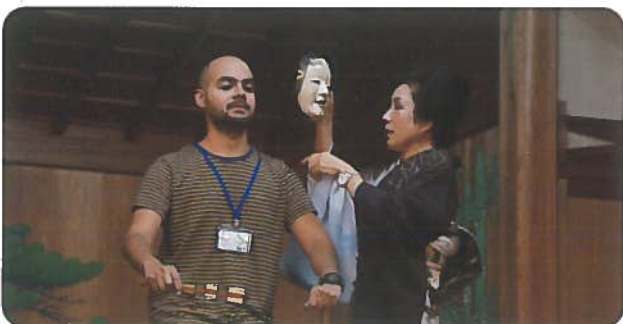


Academic

There are 46 universities and junior colleges in Kyoto, and it is also famous as a "student town." This ranks the city first in the country in terms of its number of universities per 100,000 residents. There are also about 12,000 international students from all over the world who are studying in Kyoto.

The beautiful city is known for being the capital of Japan and the residence of the Emperor for over a thousand years, from 794 until the Meiji Restoration in 1868 when the capital was moved to Tokyo.

Academic Programs

Doshisha University has grown to be one of the major universities in Japan, with 14 Faculties and 16 Graduate Schools as well as with the Center for Global Education and the Center for Japanese Language and Culture. It currently accommodates about 28,000 students, including about 1,500 international students from all around the world. We offer English-based degree programs and are working for further promotion of our internationalism.

The Imadegawa Library houses approximately 800,000 books and the Learned Memorial Library at Kyotanabe Campus about 250,000. Students can also access a wide range of multimedia resources and databases. The libraries are dedicated to supporting the full range of students' academic activities.

"Learning Commons" is a study space equipped with various facilities to turn inspiration into actualization. Learning Commons in Imadegawa Campus covers over approximately 2,550m² – the largest of its kind among of Japan's universities and helps to promote various new kind of learning. Kyotanabe Campus has also opened new Learning Commons in April 2018, at the Learned Memorial Library.

There are also scholarships offered by the Japanese government (Monbukagakusho: MEXT), Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO), local governments, and private organizations other than our own scholarships. For your information, the average monthly living cost in Kyoto is estimated at about 120,000 yen including rent.

外国人留学生入試において一定の成績基準を満たした外国人留学生に対して20%~100%の授業料減免となる奨学金を設けています(給付人数の割合は入学する学部・研究科により異なります)。同志社大学独自の奨学金以外に文部科学省奨学金、日本学生支援機構奨学金、地方公共団体の奨学金、その他民間団体奨学金等も多数あります。参考:京都での平均生活費は、住居費を含めて月額12万円程度かかります。

Housing

We introduce real estate agencies and offer dormitories operated by the University or other organizations.

If you want to rent a private housing such as an apartment in Japan, Doshisha University has partnership with some real estate companies and a private guarantor company. We recommend to use Doshisha University's partner companies to ensure that our international students can smoothly complete their rental contract.

Support by Peer Supporters and Tutors

We offer International Peer Support Program to help international students adjust smoothly to student life in Japan. Doshisha peer supporters give advice on their studies and daily lives as well as being their cross-cultural exchange partners. Meanwhile, the Tutor System for Study and Research Support for International Students is for helping graduate international students make rapid progress in their learning and research.

Japanese Language and Culture Subjects

In addition, a counseling service, "Office Hours," is offered by full-time faculty to provide advice on Japanese language studies to international students.

② Doshisha Global Archives

Student Voice

During my undergraduate degree at my university in Canada, I studied Japanese as a foreign language and quickly became fascinated by Japanese culture and the language itself. Eventually, I had the opportunity to study abroad in Kyoto and very much enjoyed the experience. When it came time to graduate and continue towards a Master's degree, I wanted to continue my studies in an environment where I could continue to use and improve my Japanese skills. While researching universities located in Kyoto, Doshisha stood out as a respected institution, with established laboratories in the exact field I was interested in. In the fall of 2016, I began my Master's degree in the International Science and Technology Course (ISTC). Although I had already studied Japanese for several years, the ISTC program allowed me to take my Master's degree courses in English, which was a great help as I was still unfamiliar with scientific Japanese at the academic level. The university also provided a lot of support in getting myself established here in Japan and setting everything up. My laboratory environment was very welcoming and provided a great atmosphere to conduct interesting research in my field. Thanks to the scholarship, I was able to enroll with reduced tuition, and am able to focus on my studies without having to divide my time between research and a part-time job. After completing my Master's degree, I decided to continue my research and am currently a PhD student. I'm glad I made the decision to come study at Doshisha.

私はカナダの大学に在籍する時に、日本語を勉強し始め、すぐに日本文化と日本語そのものに魅了されました。それは最終的に、京都に留学する機会につながり、素晴らしい経験をする事となりました。卒業して修士課程に進むとき、日本語を使い続ける環境で勉強をしたかったので、京都の大学を調べたところ、同志社の知名度が際立っており、やってみたい分野の研究室も設置されていることを知りました。そして2016年の秋、国際科学技術コース(ISTC)のプログラムで入学しました。ISTCプログラムでは、修士課程を英語で学ぶことができ、私は既に数年間日本語を勉強していたものの、科学分野における専門的な日本語にはまだ自信がなかったので、非常に助かりました。また、日本で生活するにあたり、大学からたくさんの支援を受ける事ができました。研究室の方も非常に歓迎してくださり、興味深い分野で研究ができるような素晴らしい雰囲気がありました。金銭面においても、奨学金での支援があった為、アルバイトに時間を割くことなく研究に集中することができました。卒業後も研究を続けることになり、現在も同志社大学の博士課程で勉強しています。同志社に留学して良かったです。
